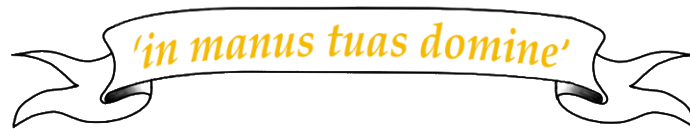

Beginning at 3pm with sung Evensong at the Anglican Parish Church of the Holy Cross, Church Lane followed by a procession to the statue of St Boniface in Newcombes Meadow and then to the National Shrine of St Boniface, Park Road. The pilgrimage concludes with Solemn Benediction at approx 4.30pm in St Boniface Church adjoining the shrine followed by light refreshments.
