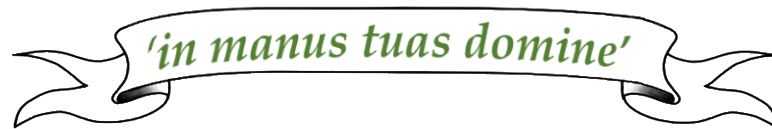

“My sincere thanks to Canon Deeny and the Parish Clergy for spiritual care, our congregation for prayers and messages of support for my wife and myself throughout my five-week hospitalisation and since.
