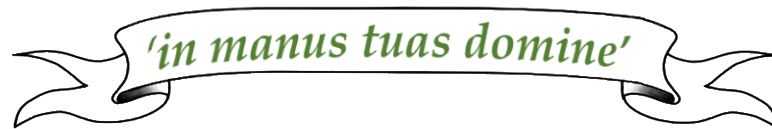

I shall however continue to be an Altar server. Please continue to pray for me."*
