

The home blessing can be done as follows: use the blessed chalk to write:

20 + C + M + B + 20 above the doorways: 2020 for the year; C, M, B for the 3 Magi ~ Casper, Melchior and Balthasar ~ and for *Christus Mansionem Benedicat*, Latin for "May Christ Bless this House"

As you are writing, pray the following prayer: Lord our God, bless this household, may we be blessed with health, goodness of heart, gentleness and the keeping of your law We give thanks to you, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, now and for ever. Amen.
