### NHS Track and Trace QR Codes

The NHS have brought out a new NHS COVID 19 app (launched 24<sup>th</sup> September), designed to simplify the process of collecting Track and Trace details, in case they need to trace anyone should there be a coronavirus infection.

The aim is that by using a digital collection system, the process of tracking those who may be potentially infected will be improved. In the event someone tests positive for coronavirus, the app will notify the people they have been in contact with. The app will not mention the church, hall, or office, but it will point you in the direction of public health.

You will need to download the app onto your Smartphone or similar device. There are posters at each of the Churches displaying a QR code. Whenever you attend Church you scan the QR code and it registers your visit. These codes are specifically for our Churches.
