Pope Francis ~ 'Fratelli Tutti'

The first words of Pope Francis' new encyclical '**Fratelli Tutti**' come from St Francis of Assisi – whose name Pope Francis chose when he was elected in 2013. It takes its inspiration from St Francis' Admonitions 6 – Of the Imitation of the Lord:

“Let us all, brothers, consider the Good Shepherd who to save his sheep bore the suffering of the Cross.”
