**Pope Francis and Civil Unions**; Several parishioners have asked if the Pope has changed teaching, given his widely reported comments in the media. The short answer is no. He has changed the pastoral tone in which the Church approaches LGBT people. These words of Boston's Cardinal Sean O'Malley, a chief adviser of the Pope, might help clarify:

He said in a statement that Francis "strongly and consistently teaches that marriage is between a man and woman for a lifetime and that this is God's plan for having and raising children." The pope's "endorsement of civil unions is not an endorsement of homosexual activity," the Cardinal said, while also noting that Francis is "very aware of the suffering and alienation of homosexual individuals, gay people, who are rejected by family and society." "Our task," Cardinal O'Malley said, "is to show people that we love them and care about them and that together we can strive to be better people, more generous, more courageous and more faithful to what God is calling us to do."
