

We have successfully bid for a further £21,000 of funding so far in 2021, thanks to Caritas and a joint funding bid with them the Gubay Foundation Trust have given us £15,000 and the Devon Coronavirus Fund have also given us another £6,000. This money will be used to provide financial support to vulnerable children and their families through our Essential Grants programme, where the basic essentials of life such as children's beds, white goods like cookers, fridge/freezers and washing machines and also school uniform including school shoes can be bought by us for vulnerable children and their families living in the Diocese. We have been actively promoting our Essential Grants programme in Dorset and Cornwall, as we are particularly keen to receive application forms for our help from families living in these counties, as well as Devon. Let us pray that we may experience the sacrament of reconciliation with renewed depth, to taste the infinite mercy of God.


