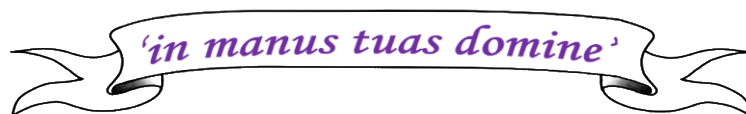

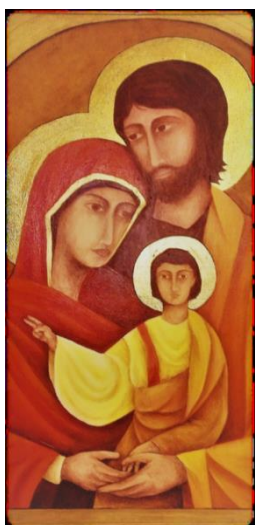
Fr John will be available for Confessions during Lent, half an hour before each weekday Mass.
