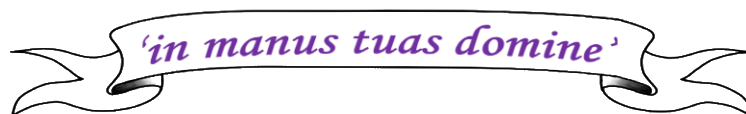

National Day of Prayer and Reflection for COVID-19

The Prime Minister has asked for a National Day of Reflection on the first anniversary of the first lockdown this coming 23rd March. The President and Vice President of the Bishops Conference have developed this theme asking all Catholics to hold this day not only as one of Reflection but of Prayer, with an encouragement for all our people to pay a visit to churches and pray for the many needs, hopes and sorrows that have emerged over the last year. **St Cuthbert Mayne Church, Launceston** will be open from **9am** until **1pm** (with Mass at 10am) to allow parishioners to visit for prayer and reflection.

The prayers for the Mass that day will be from Mass in time of Pandemic and the readings will be the Lenten readings, a minute's silence will be kept in the church at the appointed time of 12noon.

**Good Friday** is a day of Fasting and Abstinence, those of us who are able should try and miss one meal and refrain from eating meat. There will also be a retiring collection for the Holy Places, please drop your donation in the basket at the entrance of the church.

Due to covid restrictions new guidelines have been issued by Bishop Mark O'Toole regarding the celebrations of Holy Week. These changes will include omitting the washing of feet on Maundy Thursday, parishioners venerating the Cross on Good Friday from their seats and only the Paschal Candle being lit at the Easter Vigil. The congregation will not be able to take part when the Passion is read on Palm Sunday and Good Friday.

**Discernment weekend for men aged 30 to 55**

The Beda College in Rome is running a discernment weekend for men between the ages of 30 and 55 from **Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> September** to **Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> September 2021**.
