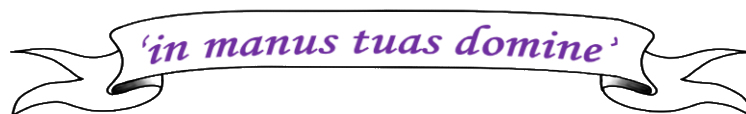

Due to covid restrictions new guidelines have been issued by Bishop Mark O'Toole regarding the celebrations of Holy Week. These changes will include omitting the washing of feet on Maundy Thursday, parishioners venerating the Cross on Good Friday from their seats and only the Paschal Candle being lit at the Easter Vigil. The congregation will not be able to take part when the Passion is read on Palm Sunday and Good Friday.

Good Friday is a day of Fasting and Abstinence, those of us who are able should try and miss one meal and refrain from eating meat. There will also be a retiring collection for the Holy Places, please drop your donation in the basket at the entrance of the church.

path of life.*

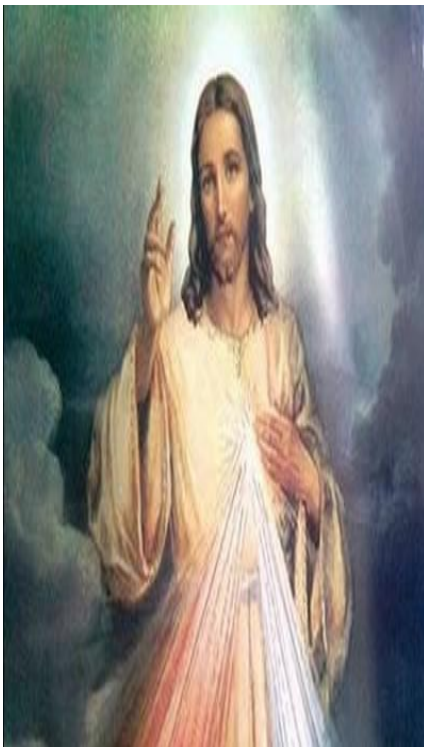
*Obtain for us grace, mercy, and

Divine Mercy Sunday is celebrated on the Second Sunday of Easter. It is based on the private revelations of St Faustina Kowalska, which recommended a particular devotion to the Divine Mercy. In 2000, Pope John Paul II canonized St Faustina and, during the ceremony, he declared:

“It is important then that we accept the whole message that comes to us from the word of God on this Second Sunday of Easter, which from now on throughout the Church will be called "Divine Mercy Sunday”

The Chaplet of Divine Mercy is a set of prayers used as part of the Divine Mercy devotion. They are usually said using a standard set of Rosary beads, often at 3 pm, the time of Jesus' death, but with a different set of prayers than those used in the Marian Rosary.
