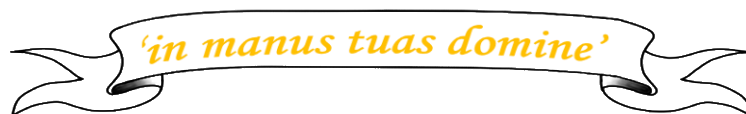

Diocese of Plymouth Environmental Policy: Please find attached a pastoral message from Bishop Mark, together with our new Policy. I will soon give an update about some things we are doing as a parish. If any of you have a special interest in helping take things forward in this regard, please let me know. There will also soon be a new section on our diocesan website to share Catholic Social Teaching and useful materials on environmental issues. There is already much positive action in our parishes and schools; but this is an area we all need to give much more attention to. Again, I recommend you reading Pope Francis' document 'Laudato Si', on Care for our Common Home.

St Cuthbert Mayne Church: You will have noticed that the scaffolding is now down from the exterior of the church. The church is revealed in all its beauty. However, the scaffolding inside the building will remain for 4 or 5 weeks, while interior works and decoration are carried out.

Sunday Mass can still be celebrated in the church although, if the weather is fine, we will attempt to celebrate Mass in the churchyard. Weekday Mass will continue to be celebrated in the parish hall.

As restrictions are being eased so we are **beginning to see visitors to the parish**, especially at Bude. We are delighted to be able to welcome them. With continued social distancing in our churches, more people coming to Mass might be a challenge to our capacity, especially at St Peter's, so I do ask for your continued patience and understanding.
