Message from Fr John

The Feast of the Ascension is this Thursday 13th May. We remember the words of St Paul: 'If you have risen with Christ, set your hearts on the things that are above where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God; seek the things that are above, not the things that are on earth.' (Colossians 3:1). Although obligations are still suspended, it is a great feast of the Church to be celebrated if you can. The times of Masses are given in the Ordo.

The prayer initiative **Thy Kingdom Come**, which takes place on the days from Ascension Day to Pentecost (13-23rd May), begins next week. Churches Together in Launceston are actively participating in this prayer. The day of prayer for St Cuthbert Mayne is Saturday 15th, so do please look up the resources below, and join in, especially on that day. It is also a world-wide Christian initiative, and something which all parishioners in Bude and Callington can also be a part of. It links in well with our traditional **Novena to the Holy Spirit**. Our **Bishop Mark O'Toole**, Chair of the Bishops' Conference's Department for Evangelisation and Discipleship, supports the global 'Thy Kingdom Come' prayer initiative and encourages Catholics to pray for and help people come to know Jesus Christ between the great Easter celebrations of the Ascension and Pentecost. Catholics often use this time to pray a novena - nine days of prayer - for an outpouring of the Holy Spirit. Bishop Mark urges Catholics to engage with those who, for whatever reason, no longer come to Church or have never done so. Act now and stop disability abortion up to birth in NI

Earlier this year the Northern Ireland Assembly voted on the Severe Fetal Impairment Abortion (Amendment) Bill and it passed Second Stage by 48 votes to 12.

The Northern Ireland Health Committee is now undertaking a consultation on the Bill and is seeking submissions from the public. It is important that as many people as possible submit to the consultation in support of the Bill to clearly show that there is widespread support for this important change.
