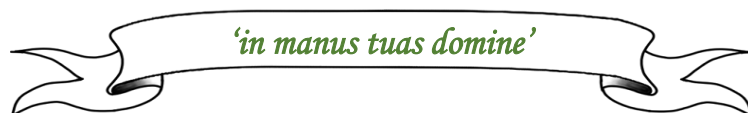

**Restrictions are due to be eased** further or possibly lifted altogether on 19th July. We can expect to receive more guidance from the Catholic Bishops Conference about singing in church, social distancing and face masks, etc. So, we will know more in the near future.

**At St Cuthbert Mayne**, there is still much work to be done in the church over the summer, including heating, lighting and flooring. I have agreed with the architect, builders, etc, that we will not use the church during the week until the end of August when the works should be completed inside the church. **Therefore, as from now, all weekday Masses at Launceston will be in the Parish Hall. Sunday Masses will be in the church, as usual.**

I intend starting **Saturday morning Masses, Eucharistic devotions, etc**, when things are more settled and we are fully back in the Church, hopefully at the beginning of September.

**I am very grateful** to you parishioners for your understanding and patience with all that you have had to put up with during Covid times, and also with all the works going on. Also, our great thanks to all working on our church, who are doing such a great job.

There has been some people interested in a possible *Children's Liturgy at beginning of Mass* at Our Lady of Victories Callington. Please let me know if you are interested in being involved. This would be a great step forward. We love to see children at Mass, and want to give them all the support they need. The same applies to all our churches. We would need a few adult leaders, and can find suitable resources.
