The theme that Pope Francis has chosen for this year's World Mission Sunday is **'We cannot but speak about what we have seen and heard'**, words spoken by St John and St Peter in the Acts of the Apostles (4:20).

We are reminded by the Holy Father in his letter for World Mission Sunday that 'to be on mission is to be willing to think as Christ does, to believe with him that those around us are also my brothers and sisters. May his compassionate love touch our hearts and make us all true missionary disciples'.
