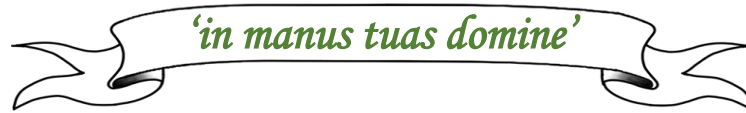

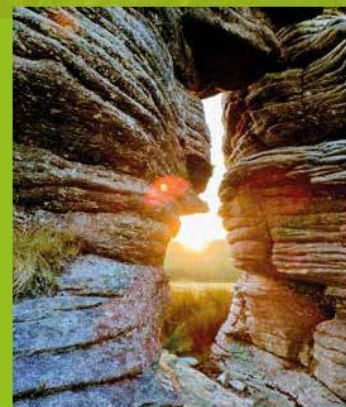
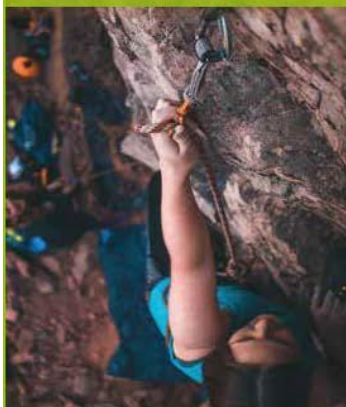
## Fancy meeting other young catholics across our diocese?
