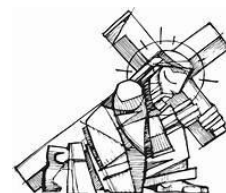
### Confessions

## Pray for Peace in Ukraine

Cardinal Vincent Nichols has urged the Catholic community to pray for peace in Ukraine as Western nations warn that Russia could invade its neighbour at any time.
