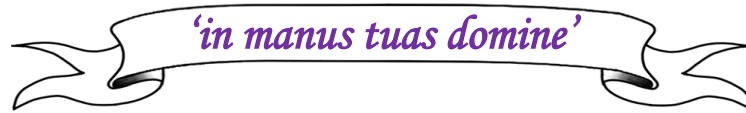

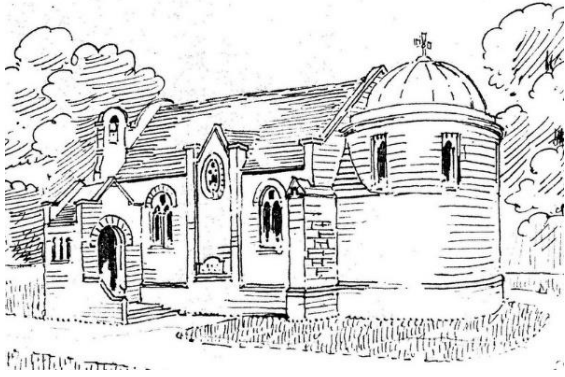


**Pope's Intention for the month of March:**
