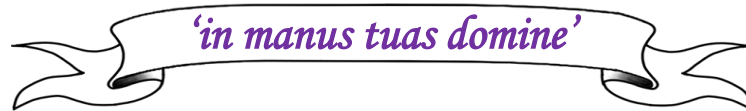

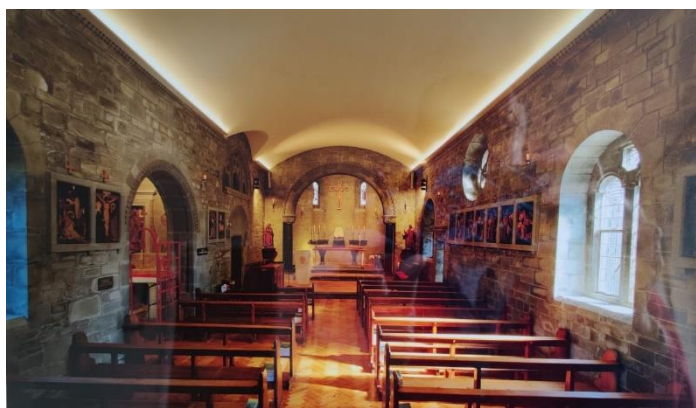

Holy Father's Act of Consecration of Russia and Ukraine to the Immaculate Heart of Mary

On Friday 25th March 2022, Solemnity of the Annunciation the Holy Father consecrated Russia and Ukraine to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. Each Diocesan bishop was invited to unite his Diocese with this Act through the praying of the Act of Consecration in each of the Diocesan Cathedrals in England and Wales. Fr John will pray the Act of Consecration at Mass at Callington on Friday 25th March.

Next **Saturday 2nd April**, in place of our usual Lenten Stations of the Cross, we will **pray the Rosary with the special intention of Peace in Ukraine**, appealing to the prayers of Our Lady Queen of Peace. The Rosary will follow the 10 am Mass at St Cuthbert Mayne Church

They are waiting in Hamburg at the moment (the application process is a nightmare!!).
