### Silent Witness for babies killed by Abortion: Saturday 30th April 11am - 1pm:

This month also marks 54 years of the legalised killing of nearly 10 million unborn babies in the UK. Babies are not commodities to be generated and got rid of at will. ## Cleaner Vacancy

### St Cuthbert Mayne Church, Launceston

As from April, Launceston will have a vacancy for a Cleaner. The role will require the jobholder to carry out essential tasks to ensure the cleanliness and maintenance of the Church Hall/Outside toilet on a weekly basis and the Presbytery on a monthly basis.

The role requires the jobholder, working within Health & Safety guidelines, to ensure that the Hall/Outside toilet and Presbytery are cleaned to a high standard providing a clean, safe and pleasant environment so it can be used by the Parish and those who hire the Hall and the Parish Priest.

The jobholder will also have responsibility for reporting any breakages/ damages or any maintenance requirements promptly to the Parish Priest.

This is a part-time post where the jobholder will be required to work 1.5 hours per week and to demonstrate some flexibility in order to ensure that the Hall/Outside toilet is prepared for any specific occasions. The salary is £9.50 per hour (reviewed in April) – the National Living Wage Foundation wage.

The key skills required are attention to detail, the ability to work unsupervised, together with an awareness of the importance of confidentiality.
