New appointment for Bishop Mark

Bishop Mark has been appointed as new Archbishop of Cardiff and Bishop of Menevia dioceses. He will be installed on **20th June**. I attach a copy of the letter he sent to clergy last Wednesday.

We have been very blessed to have Bishop Mark in Plymouth diocese for the past 8 years. The sad news for our diocese is good news for the dioceses in Wales. On a personal level, I am very grateful for the trust and support Bishop Mark has shown me over those years. It will be some time, probably a few months, before a new Bishop is appointed to our diocese. **We keep Bishop Mark in our prayers.**

A Diocesan **Mass of Thanksgiving** for the leadership and ministry of Bishop Mark as Bishop of Plymouth will be celebrated at the **Cathedral of St Mary and St Boniface, Plymouth, on Monday, 30 May, at 12noon.**

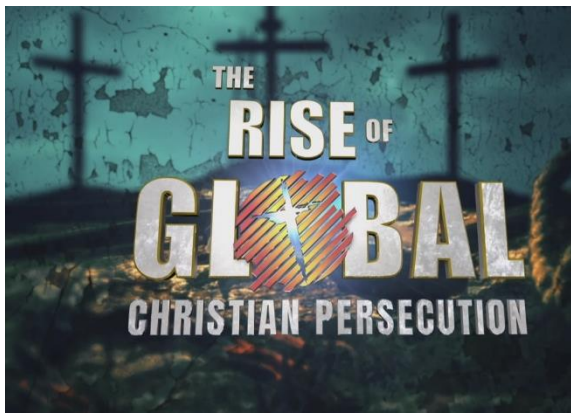
CARE FOR OUR COMMON HOME:
