## Sea Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> July 2022

Seafarers and fishers play a vital role in all of our lives, but they often work in difficult, hazardous conditions. In the last year, more crews have been abandoned by their employers than ever before. Many are still being denied the right to leave their ships for even a short break away from the relentless noise and pressure onboard. Many are reporting more stress and poorer mental health.

**Sea Sunday is Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> July.** It is when the Church prays for all those who live and work at sea. Your support will make a big difference to seafarers and fishers in need. The sessions will be led by a team of peer facilitators, and will look at themes specific to faith-based abuse, what helps on the path of healing and recovery, as well as having open sharing.
