Trafficking in persons is a serious crime and a violation of human rights. Thousands of men, women and children fall victim to traffickers every year. Victims lose their rights and are forced to work, often doing hard labour or prostitution, but receive no payment. Additionally, they also frequently have their documents taken from them and are threatened with punishment if they should try to escape.
