His **Requiem Mass** will take place at the Sacred Heart on the following day, **Friday 5th May, at midday.** Archbishop John Wilson will preside.

There will be a reception after the Mass at the Hotel Mercure Southgate from 2.00pm. Bishop Christopher's body will be interred at the cemetery at Buckfast Abbey later that afternoon.
