World Day of Prayer for Vocations Sunday 30th April

This Sunday is the World Day of Prayer for Vocations, also known as Good Shepherd Sunday. It is an opportunity to pray for vocations and to encourage those who may be considering ordained or religious life.

The Diocese of Plymouth also asks for your assistance in supporting our seminarians through their training and formation, both through prayer and financial support. It costs around $\pounds35,500$ per year to fund and seminarian and by September the Diocese will have three men in major seminary and are hoping this will rise to five next year.
