Newly refurbished shields for St Cuthbert Mayne porch: A big **thank you** to Pamela who has skillfully restored the 3 shields of the coat of Arms of each of the three martyrs. which hangs in the church porch. They will be blessed at the end of Mass today. The photos don't do justice but give an idea of the transformation from their dilapidated state to how they look now.



St John Fisher – thought to be a ‘pun’ on the name Fisher (fish-ear) with ears of barley and fish. The Scallop shell is thought to represent Whitstable a key town in the Diocese of Rochester, where he was Bishop at the time of his martyrdom.



St Cuthbert Mayne – the hand is emblematic of faith and the trefoil is a symbol of the Holy Trinity.



St Thomas More – the adjoining chevrons form the letter M, Moorcock’s are a ‘pun’ on the name More and the Unicorns are thought to represent important members of the More family, though they are also a sign of courage. The gold coins are symbolic of Thomas’ royal position.

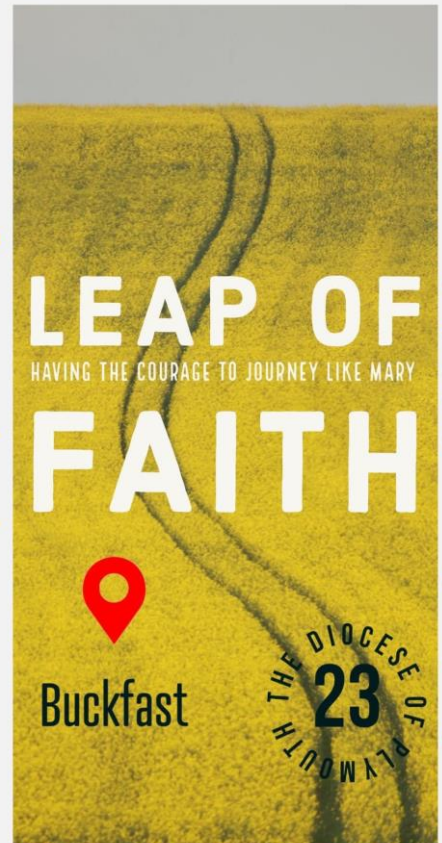
