Laudate Deum (Praise God): Pope Francis has published his update to Laudato Si', '**Laudate Deum**.' It is a strong critique of those who say that climate change is not happening; of wealthy countries for their consumption and blaming the poor and it argues that change needs to happen at political and strategic levels as well as the change of heart of individuals and communities. Pope Francis suggests that 'Our world has become so multipolar and at the same time so complex that a different framework for effective cooperation is required.' He argues that too much power is in the hands of a few and that "Praise God" is the title of this letter. For when human beings claim to take God's place, they become their own worst enemies." Saints Way Pilgrimage

We will stay overnight 7/8 November in the parish halls of St Mary and St Petroc in Bodmin, sleeping bags will be required. Transport from St Cuthbert Mayne to Padstow and from Fowey to St Cuthbert Mayne has been arranged.

The Saints Way is a 30 mile route from Padstow to Fowey and believed to have been used by Christian Missionaries and pilgrims en route to Rome, Santiago de Compostela and even the Holy Land.
