Training day: Sat 28th October

This will take place on **Saturday 28th October at 11.30am at Launceston parish.**

The training day will consist of 3 modules of learning as follows:

Module 1: The Body & Blood of Christ – Source & summit of the Catholic faith.

This module explores scriptural historical references, including the co-operation between God and humankind.

Module 2: A Way of Life.

Examines all practical aspects of ministering both at the altar & taking Holy Communion to the sick & housebound.

Module 3: An encounter with Jesus.

What other service can Eucharistic Ministers provide?

The day will consist of a short break after the first module and a lunch break after the second.

Please note as this is a full day event you will need to bring a packed lunch. Drinks and biscuits will be available.

Saints Way Pilgrimage

A parish pilgrimage along the Saints Way is planned for the **7th and 8th of November**. Our intention is to walk approximately **15 miles of the route each day** at a leisurely pace taking in the religious sites and the beautiful Cornish scenery. We will stay overnight 7/8 November in the parish halls of St Mary and St Petroc in Bodmin, sleeping bags will be required. Transport from St Cuthbert Mayne to Padstow and from Fowey to St Cuthbert Mayne has been arranged.

The Saints Way is a 30 mile route from Padstow to Fowey and believed to have been used by Christian Missionaries and pilgrims en route to Rome, Santiago de Compostela and even the Holy Land.
