#### St Cuthbert Mayne Church Dome

For your information: Following close inspection of the copper dome of the church, we were informed that it has gone beyond its lifespan and is in need of renewal. Works should be carried out to avoid ongoing issues of leakage and damage to the stone dome structure which is set below the copper covering. After consultation with the Parish Finance Committee and the Parish Pastoral Council, Fr John has sought permission from the diocese to carry out works on the dome. Approval has been granted to apply to the Historic Churches Committee for permission to carry out the works, re-coppering of the east end dome roof, and replacement of defective lead guttering to the east end dome roof. This will be a like for like re-coppering and replacement. Members of the Historic Churches committee are visiting the church later in November. As required, there is a public notice of the works on the church notice board.

#### Pope Francis message on the Climate Crisis

Pope Francis has written a new message calling for world leaders to tackle the climate crisis and make the most of the upcoming COP28 climate summit.

The Pope says the climate disasters we've seen in recent times show we're approaching "breaking point". He warns we're running out of time to prevent even more tragic damage for communities that have contributed least to causing the crisis. With COP28 just a month away, it's crucial MPs hear about the Pope's message.

The Pope says in his message, called *Laudate Deum*, that leaders attending the COP28 talks must put the interests of our global family first in the negotiations. CAFOD have produced a summary of the Pope's message for MPs and are asking you to share this summary with your MP.
