Blessings

The church's new document (Declaration Fiducia Supplicans on the meaning of pastoral blessings) does not allow for blessings of same sex marriages or unions. It does, however, allow for blessing of people, including those in same sex relationships. Here are quotes from the text:

"...rites and prayers that could create confusion between what constitutes marriage – which is an "exclusive, stable and indissoluble union between a man and a woman, naturally open to the generation of children" – and what contradicts it are inadmissible. This conviction is grounded in the perennial Catholic doctrine of marriage; it is only in this context that sexual relations find their natural, proper and fully human meaning. The Church's doctrine on this point remains firm ... that the Church does not have the power to impart blessings on unions of persons of the same sex ... or confer its liturgical blessing when that would somehow offer a form of moral legitimacy to a union that presumes to be a marriage or to an extra marital sexual practice."

What it did say about blessings was: "In order to help us understand the value of a more pastoral approach to blessings, Pope Francis urges us to contemplate, with an attitude of faith and fatherly mercy, the fact that "when one asks for a blessing, one is expressing a petition for God's assistance, a plea to live better, and confidence in a Father who can help us live better. ... The Church is thus the sacrament of God's infinite love. Therefore, even when a person's relationship with God is clouded by sin, he can always ask for a blessing, stretching out his hand to God, as Peter did in the storm when he cried out to Jesus, 'Lord, save me!'."

This world needs blessings, and we can give blessings and receive blessings. The Father loves us, and the only thing that remains for us is the joy of blessing him, and the joy of thanking him, and of learning from him to bless." In this way, every brother and every sister will be able to feel that, in the Church, they are always pilgrims, always beggars, always loved, and, despite everything, always blessed."
