Buildings update (for information):

Our Lady of Victories, Callington: Repointing of the far gable wall, repairs to the roof, stained glass window surround, and leaking hall window have all been repaired, and the work done has been very good.



There has been serious water ingress to the porch area, which was flooded before Christmas. The remaining hall windows need replacement. These outstanding works will be done in about 6 weeks' time, which is when the contractors are available to carry out the works. We had a quinquennial survey last Tuesday. Please God it won't throw up any surprises!



St Peter's, **Bude**: The diocese property team has been in touch with the architects to communicate what we are looking for: Some sketch drawings and ballpark figures. Necessary to be revamped are the toilet area, sacristy, confessional. They will also look at possibility of extending the annex. When we have heard back from the architects, we will discuss with parishioners.

The Clerk of Works for the diocese also visited St Peter's to advise us on making the most of the car park area, and smartening up the front of the church. New signage is being planned to be seen from the road.

St Cuthbert Mayne: Waiting for news on the dome. We have all the permissions from Historic Churches, and the Diocese. Things have been delayed by the Council who have said we need planning permission. This has surprised our advisors from Historic Churches and David Scott, very experienced Chartered Surveyor, who oversaw the recent renewal of the church building, who said he has never heard of such a thing for this kind of work. He is in negotiations with the Council.
