*"The Episcopal Ordination of Canon Christopher Whitehead will not take place on 22nd February 2024 as expected. Canon Paul Cummins continues as the Diocesan Administrator. A canonical process is currently underway, and no further comments will be made until this process has been concluded. Canon Christopher Whitehead has stepped back from active ministry whilst this process is ongoing."*

I am sure that this will come as surprise and that you may have many questions, but this is all the information that I have for you. The mission of the Diocese to proclaim the Good News will still go on as before, and with your support, I will do all I can to continue to serve that mission.
