## Cafod and Caritas

What is the difference between these two?



### In general terms:

**Cafod** stands for Catholic Agency for Overseas Development. As the name suggests, it particularly supports the poor and those in need in other countries.

**Caritas** (in this country) is a word meaning Love in Action or Charity, supports the poor and those in need in our own place. Priorities for Caritas are: the lonely and isolated, Children and Families, Refugees and Migrants, the homeless.

Cafod and Caritas are sister charities so there is a good deal of overlap between them. They both promote and educate regarding the treasure of the Church which is Catholic Social Teaching. They also both promote care for God's creation. In many other countries Caritas covers the work done by Cafod and Caritas and supports people at home and abroad. We have a different history in this country.

We can rightly be proud of the outreach of the Church to support those in need whoever, and wherever, they are. It is an expression of Christ's command to love one another as I have loved you.

## Pilgrimage to Buckfast Abbey

We are planning a coach trip/pilgrimage to Buckfast Abbey in the summer. We are looking at the week of the 15<sup>th</sup> July leaving Bude at 9am (then stopping at Launceston and Callington), returning to Bude around 5:30pm. Cost of coach will be £15 per person. We will visit the Abbey Church, and grounds, celebrate Mass, have lunch at the Grange, and visit the Exhibition Centre. The Monastic Way Exhibition is an immersive presentation of Benedictine monastic life, from its origins to the present day. The meal and Exhibition Centre (£2) will be extra costs for those who want them. Ideally, we would like to take a 39-seater coach. We need to (almost) fill it, to make it affordable. This is advanced notice that there will be a list at the back of our churches from this weekend to see how many people are interested.

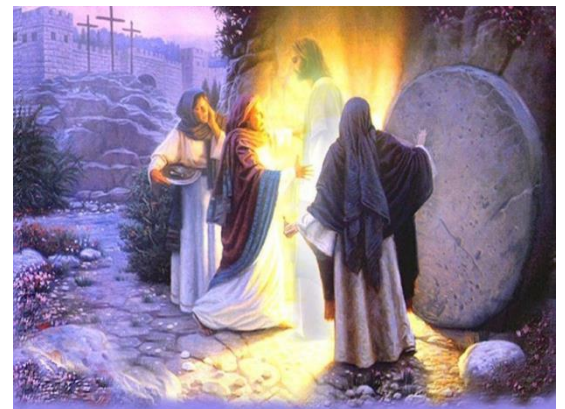


## Recycle 4 Chrity Ink Cartridge Box
