
Diocese of Plymouth: Seminarians' Fund

Pilgrimage to Buckfast Abbey

Tuesday 16th July

Leaving Bude (Crescent car park) at 9am (then stopping at Launceston and Callington) we will get to Buckfast for around 11am. We will visit the Abbey Church, and grounds, celebrate Mass at 12noon, have lunch at the Grange, and visit the Exhibition Centre. The Monastic Way Exhibition is an immersive presentation of Benedictine monastic life, from its origins to the present day. The meal and Exhibition Centre (£2) will be extra costs for those who want them.

The coach will be £15 per person and sign-up sheets are available in each Church.

Cashless Giving: Coming to Launceston soon...

We have just received our new giving station and will start trialing cashless giving in the next few weeks. This will initially be in Launceston as there Wi-Fi in Church, but we will be rolling it out to try at both Bude and Callington. If successful we have a giving station in each church by the summer.



The giving stations will allow donations to loose plate, second collections and for book or votive sales.

To try it in each church we would need one or two volunteers who can take responsibility for making sure the machine is set up before each Mass and to explain how it is used to anyone who needs help.
