International Mass, followed by shared lunch (Planning Meeting):

We are planning an International Mass at St Cuthbert Mayne Church, date still to be arranged. In our Sunday congregation we have parishioners from various nations, including our own, who have made their home here. I invite one, or more, representatives from each nation to come to a **meeting to help in the planning, in St Cuthbert Mayne hall after Mass on Sunday 26th May after the 10.30am Mass.**

We would like to include the languages of the various nations in our prayers and readings at that Mass. Afterwards we hope also to have an 'International shared lunch', where parishioners bring food typical of their own nation to contribute to the shared lunch. Please ensure your nation is represented. Pilgrimage to Buckfast Abbey: Tuesday 16th July

Leaving Bude (Crescent car park) at 9am (then stopping at Launceston and Callington) we will get to Buckfast for around 11am. We will visit the Abbey Church, and grounds, celebrate Mass at 12noon, have lunch at the Grange, and visit the Exhibition Centre. The Monastic Way Exhibition is an immersive presentation of Benedictine monastic life, from its origins to the present day. The meal and Exhibition Centre (£2) will be extra costs for those who want them. The coach will be £15 per person and sign-up sheets are available in each Church.

Laudato Si Week 19-26 May 24:

Calling All Craft Groups & Creators to contribute to this wonderful celebration.

During Laudato Si' week, there will be an exhibition and prayer walk at Plymouth Cathedral interpreting Laudato Si' through artwork and reflections by pupils from local schools. All visitors to the Cathedral will also be invited to add to a mass participation artwork called the Mossy Carpet. People are invited to make a textile tuft such as crochet, knit, embroider, plait, pompom, tuft... or something else to attach to the carpet! This artwork will help us to consider how our small actions can make a huge change, and how our Christian faith calls us to be part of the restoration of nature.

There will be drop-in workshops from 12-4pm on Monday 20 May at the Cathedral of St Mary and St Boniface but the Mossy Carpet will be in place from 18th- 24th May for people to visit and add their contributions. Youth Adventure Residential 24th – 26th May 2024, Grangehurst, Buckfast Abbey
