Laudato Si Week 19-26 May 24:

Calling All Craft Groups & Creators to contribute to this wonderful celebration.

During Laudato Si' week, there will be an exhibition and prayer walk at Plymouth Cathedral interpreting Laudato Si' through artwork and reflections by pupils from local schools. All visitors to the Cathedral will also be invited to add to a mass participation artwork called the Mossy Carpet. People are invited to make a textile tuft such as crochet, knit, embroider, plait, pompom, tuft... or something else to attach to the carpet! This artwork will help us to consider how our small actions can make a huge change, and how our Christian faith calls us to be part of the restoration of nature.

There will be drop-in workshops from 12-4pm on Monday 20 May at the Cathedral of St Mary and St Boniface but the Mossy Carpet will be in place from 18th- 24th May for people to visit and add their contributions.
