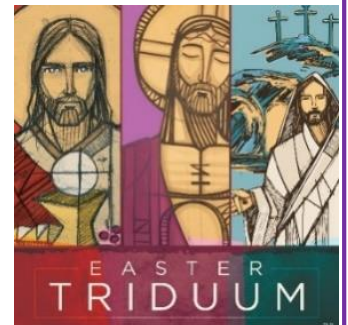

AN EASTER MESSAGE FROM FR JOHN

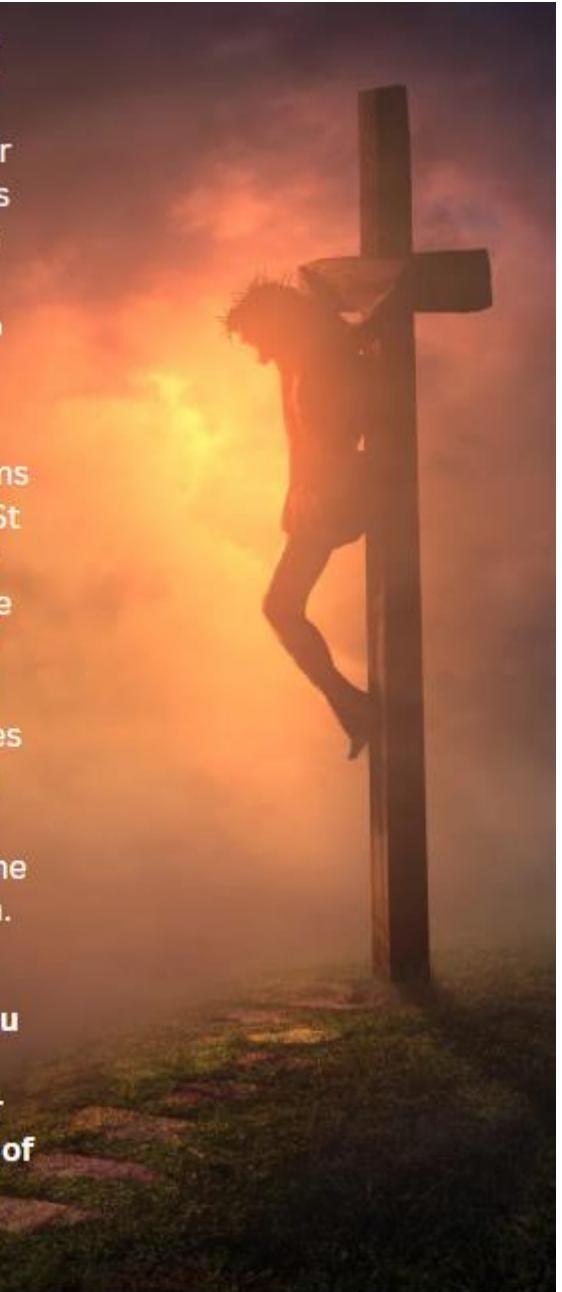

It was a blessing to celebrate the **Sacrament of Anointing the Sick** during Masses at all of our churches last weekend. Many parishioners were anointed and some visitors too. We continue to keep all those who are sick and/or housebound in our prayers, remembering also those who were physically unable to attend Mass. We also pray for all care givers and thank God for what they do in our communities. On a weekend when the Pastoral Letter on the End-of-Life (Assisted Suicide) bill was read out, the celebration of anointing gave a very positive message of how the sick, elderly and vulnerable are cherished and loved by God, and at the heart of the life of the Church, and should never be considered a burden on society. **Please don't forget to write to your MP regarding the Terminally Ill (End of Life) Bill.**

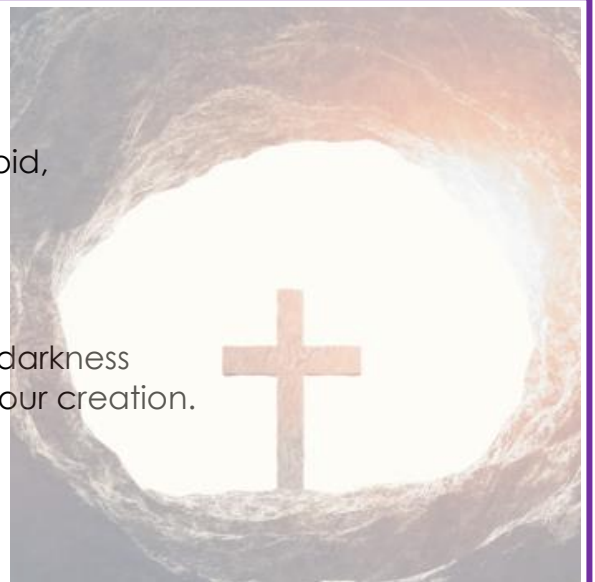
