Record breaking start to 2025



We have been totally overwhelmed by the generosity of our loyal supporters so far in 2025 as we have smashed the record breaking Orange Box recycling targets set over the last two years. In 2024, our recycling scheme raised almost £6,000 compared to the previous year's record breaking total of just over £5,500 and within the first six months of 2025, we have already raised over £30,000 so far !!

Since this recycling scheme was introduced in 2011, we have raised £61,757.87 which is absolutely amazing and we are all so grateful. Just imagine how many families we have been able to help over the last 15 years !!

Items that can be popped into your parish Orange Box include -



- Stamp collections, first day covers or old envelopes and postcards pre 1950
- Coins and banknotes – any and all, old and new, from all over the world, obsolete or otherwise
- Precious metals including broken jewellery, old trophies, gold, silver etc
- Metals including ornaments, metal toys, keys and locks, metal cutlery – any age and any condition
- Costume jewellery
- Medals
- Small antiques and collectibles
- Watches – digital, quartz or manual wind – working or not
- Any Catholic religious memorabilia such as rosaries, crucifixes, medals etc
