Parish Pilgrimage to Crediton and Dorchester

Wednesday 16th July

Four seats have become available on the coach for this trip, please speak to Fr John at Mass this weekend if you would like to come. **Please bring £20 for your ticket on the day and please remember to bring a packed lunch.**

The coach will be **leaving Bude Coach Park at 8:30am** then stopping at the top of St Stephen's Hill, **outside St Stehen's Church** (cars can be left in our car park), **leaving Launceston by 9:15am. Please arrive by 8:15am Bude / 9:00am Launceston as the coach cannot wait for late arrivals.** It is aiming to return to Bude by 7:30pm with a stop in Launceston first.

Closure of St Peter's – Crownhill.

The Diocese of Plymouth has closed St Peter's Catholic Church, the car park and the presbytery in Crownhill, Plymouth, from 10 July 2025 as a result of the findings of a structural survey.

Canon Paul Cummins said: "We are very sorry that we have had to close St Peter's church in Crownhill with immediate effect. This is not a decision that we have taken lightly: it was necessary to ensure the safety of our school pupils, parents and teachers as well as the priests, parishioners and staff."

Fr Jonathan Bielawski, the parish priest, is putting arrangements in place so that parishioners will still be able to gather together to worship as a community. Canon Paul has asked people across the deanery and diocese for their continued support and prayers as the parish explores new arrangements to celebrate the sacraments and to provide pastoral support to the local community and to sustain the activities provided at the church.

The Diocesan Property Commission will be leading on the next steps for the church buildings.
