## Residential for Teens (13-17 year olds)

January 23<sup>rd</sup> – 25<sup>th</sup>, East Shallowford Farm, Dartmoor

Teenagers who are 13- 17years old, are invited to join us at East Shallowford Farm on Dartmoor (TQ13 7PW). The theme of the weekend is to explore the scripture Matthew 25:35 whilst talking to people with refugee or asylum status. During the weekend we will work with the charity, Stories of Hope and Home and be able to talk to a small group of people with either asylum or refugee status to hear their stories. It is a great opportunity to listen but also question and understand what it is like to have lived the story these people have.

Young people are asked to arrive between 5pm and 6pm on Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> January. Parents will have a brief chance to see where their children are staying. Food and drink is included throughout the weekend. It is important that young people do not bring any snacks due to allergies and intolerance's.

During the weekend we will have a chance to join in farm life, feeding and cleaning out the animals. So it is important that young people bring clothing that can get mucky. A kit list will be circulated nearer the time. A contribution of £50 per person to assist with costs.
