Day for Life: "The Wonder of the Child in the Womb"

21st June

This Sunday, 21 June, we mark *Day for Life*, the day in the Church's calendar when we come together to celebrate the dignity of all human life from conception to natural death. This year's theme is 'The Wonder of the Child in the Womb'. A child is a gift from God to be nurtured and cherished, but the theme also recognises the tragedy of babies who died before birth and the grief experienced by their parents and families. The second collection will go toward the [Day for Life Fund](#), which distributes grants to organisations that promote respect for life from conception until natural death.
